Sub: Conduct of Indian Universities Weightlifting team selection trials to participate in the 5th World University Weightlifting Championships scheduled to be held at Merida, Mexico from 13th to 17th November, 2016 – Reg.

Ref: Letter from Dr.Gurdeep Singh, Joint Secretary (Sports), AIU, No:S/WUC/2016, Dated: 11.08.2016.

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The 5th World University Weightlifting Championships is scheduled to be held at Merida, Mexico from 13th to 17th November, 2016. Association of Indian Universities has entrusted the responsibility of conducting the selection trials of the Indian Universities Weightlifting (Men & Women) team to Acharya Nagarjuna University.

In view of the above, the universities are requested to send the talented Weightlifters of their respective universities to participate in the Selection trials of the Indian Universities Weightlifting Men & Women team **on 11th September, 2016** at Acharya Nagarjuna University Campus.

The University is located midway between Vijayawada and Guntur. There are several passenger buses shuttling between Vijayawada and Guntur. Weightlifters can get down either at Vijayawada or Guntur and board the local buses to reach Acharya Nagarjuna University.

The players attending the selection trials should produce the following documents at the time of selection trials.

1. Eligibility proforma duly signed by University Authorities(Two copies)
2. Identity Card
3. Valid Indian Passport (Original and Xerox copy)
4. Four passport size photos

The eligibility criteria prescribed by the organising committee through 5th World University Weightlifting Championships regulations is as follows: (The brochure is herewith enclosed as Annexure-1).

Eligibility Criteria for participants:

1. Be a National of the country they represent
2. Be at least 17 and less than 28 years of age.
3. Students who are currently officially registered as proceeding towards a degree or diploma at a university or similar institute whose status is recognized by the appropriate National academic authority of their country.
4. Former students of the institutions who have obtained their academic degree or diploma in the year preceding the event.

Further, the selected players have to attend coaching camp at Acharya Nagarjuna University Campus after completion of selection trials.

Since the government is not going to extend the financial assistance, the selected players should meet the total expenses for attending the selection trials and also the expenditure for attending the World University Championships from their respective universities. The approximate expenditure for each candidate is estimated as Rs.1,91,300/- (Rupees one lakh ninety one thousand and three hundred only). The detailed estimation is herewith enclosed as Annexure – 2. CBR Foundation for Sports, Vijayawada is sponsoring the expenditure for the Coaching camp.

During the selection trials, NADA is going to conduct the dope test for all the weightlifters. Further tests will be conducted at the venues as per the WADA regulations.

The Interested weightlifters should attend with all the above documents at Acharya Nagarjuna University **on 10th September, 2016 at 2.00pm**. I am herewith enclosing the results of the previous World University championships as Annexure - 3.

Regulations

1. Competition Regulation

The 2016 University World Championships will follow Technical and Competition Rules and Regulations (TCRR) of the International Weightlifting Federation (IWF).

2. Terms and Condition of Participation

Accredited participants (athletes, Team Officials, Technical Officials (TOs) media, guests, etc.):

Should acknowledge and fully comply with IWF Constitution and By-Laws, TCRR, Anti-Doping Policy (ADP)

Should abide by all reasonable directions given by the IWF, the Organizing Committee (OC), TOs

Should agree to be filmed, televised, photographed, interviewed and otherwise recorded during the Event for the purpose of the media coverage and the promotion of the sport

Should agree that any of the above mentioned images may be used by IWF and/or OC

Should assign with full title guarantee in perpetuity to the IWF all rights of any nature in any such recordings

Should accept any prize or award given by IWF and/or OC/sponsors and will attend all special award ceremonies where prizes or awards are presented

Should attend a Press Conference upon request of the IWF/OC.

Should not participate in, support or promote illegal betting

Should participate in the Event at their own risk and take all reasonable measures to protect themselves from any risk

Should undertake full moral and financial responsibility with regard to their health and wellness and in case of accidents or damages

Are responsible for all property they bring into the Event and that the IWF and/or OC shall have no responsibility in any loss or damage of this property

Acknowledge and agree that neither the IWF nor the OC shall arrange any insurance connected with the participation in the Event

Should irrevocably release IWF and OC (and their respective members, officers, employees, etc.) from liability for any loss, injury or damage that they may suffer in relation to their participation in the Event

Should guarantee that they participate in the Event with the permission of their parent(s) or guardian(s) in case they are minors

Should acknowledge that by not following the above mentioned terms and conditions, sanctions may be imposed

3. Eligibility

Only competitors who meet the following conditions may take part in the event:

- Be a national of the country they represent.
- Be at least 17 and less than 28 years of age.
- Students who are currently officially registered as proceeding towards a degree or diploma at a university or similar institute whose status is recognized by the appropriate national academic authority of their country.
- Former students of the institutions who have obtained their academic degree or diploma in the year preceding the event.

With reference to Article 5.6.4 of the IWF Anti-Doping Policy, the Athletes who are not listed in the IWF's Registered testing Pool and who want to enter an IWF Event shall nevertheless register to the ADAMS system and submit proper whereabouts information at least 2 months before the IWF Event in question. The Athletes who do not comply with this provision are not eligible to compete.

4. Deadlines

Forms must be sent together with the passport copies before the following deadlines.

4.1. Preliminary Entry Form and Preliminary Accommodation and Flight Information Form
Not later than September 12, 2016.

4.2. Final Entry Form and Final Accommodation and Flight Information Form
Not later than 15. October 2016.

4.3. Final Entry Form and Final Accommodation and Flight Information Form and photo as per section Not later than October 15, 2016

Must be sent to the following e-mail addresses:

Hotel Room List will close on October 15.

Delegations that do not submit their Final forms (Accommodation and flight Information) until October 15, will be accommodated based on available capacity in hotels (room types and quantity available at the time), and can be also accommodated in alternative hotels.

5. Arrival at Merida

Through Jose Crescencio Rejón International Airport, located in Mérida.

6. Transport

The Organizing Committee will provide transfers for all participants from International Airport Jose Crescencio Rejón to hotels and to competition and training venue.

7. Competition and Training Venue

The competition and training will take place at Poliforum Zamna in the Kukulkan Sports Complex. The Training Venue will be available from November 10, 2016.

8. Competition Equipment

ZCK – IWF licensed company.

9. Awards

Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded in each bodyweight category for both men and women in the Snatch, Clean & Jerk and Total.

10. Anthems and Flags

All Member Federations are asked to bring USB with their National Anthem and National Flag.

11. Doping Control

Doping Control will be conducted in accordance with the IWF Anti-Doping Policy.

12. Accommodation
