- b.** RESOLVED to conduct Selection trails for Boxing, Fencing, Gymnastics, Swimming, Yatching or any other individual event only when the colleges admit a talented player in the respective events after the sports board meeting. In such cases, the Director of Physical Education, ANU may take necessary steps to conduct the selection trials and send the individual talented players to participate in the Inter University tournaments. However, the colleges should intimate the names of the players and the track record of performance of such player in the respective events immediately after the admission process is completed.

**Item No.3:**

To approve the budget for the year 2016-17 presented by the Secretary, Sports Board.

RESOLVED that the budget proposals presented by the Secretary, Sports Board as per Annexure – (1) for the year 2016-17 is approved.

**Item No.4:**

**After considering the resolutions of various zonal committees and other proposals received from the members and the Secretary, Sports Board, the following resolutions are passed.**

- 1 RESOLVED to congratulate the Players, Coaches and Managers who won the medals in the Inter-University Tournaments during the year 2015-16.
- 2 RESOLVED to continue to extend Sports Scholarships for the academic year 2016-17 also.
- 3 RESOLVED to conduct of selection trials and fielding the Indian Universities Weightlifting Team - 2016 in the 5<sup>th</sup> World University Weightlifting Championships – 2016 at Merida, Mexico from 13<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup> November, 2016.

- 4 RESOLVED to revise the rates of DA / other allowances for players, officials participating in the Inter-University Tournaments from the academic year 2016-17 as follows.
  - a. DA for players during university team coaching camp: Rs.175/- per day
  - b. DA for players during participation in the inter university tournament and also during journey days: Rs.250/- per day
  - c. DA for team Managers, Coaches, Selection committee members: Rs.300/- per day
  - d. Team contingency: Rs.2000/- per team
  - e. TA & DA for Marker during the Inter-University Tournament and Journey days : On par with players
- 5 RESOLVED to revise the financial assistance to be given to the organising colleges of the Inter-Collegiate tournaments as Rs.4000/- from the academic year 2016-17 as per Annexure-2.
- 6 RESOLVED to revise the officiating charges to be collected by the organising colleges from each college team from the academic year 2016-17 as per Annexure-3.
- 7 RESOLVED to adopt the new eligibility rules of AIU from the academic year 2016-17, wherein the age limit for the participation in the Inter-University tournament is fixed as 17 to 25 years for all games.
- 8 RESOLVED to conduct Inter-Collegiate Athletics, Weightlifting, Powerlifting and Best Physique competitions in two age categories i.e., **Juniors**: From 17 to 20 Years and **Seniors** : Above 20 to 25 Years. (The calculation of the age should be to the 1<sup>st</sup> July of the academic year). Further, RESOLVED to issue Merit certificates to both the age categories. (This procedure may be adopted on trail basis for the academic year 2016-17).
- 9 The proposal of the Colleges to permit the Physical Education College Students to participate in the University Team selections only was not considered, as it is against the rules of the Natural Justice. All Colleges and students should get equal opportunity to participate either in the Inter-Collegiate Tournament or in the University team selections. However to encourage more participation in Inter-Collegiate tournaments, it is resolved that whenever the University College of Physical Education & Sports Sciences, ANU wins a medal, the University College of Physical Education & Sports Sciences, ANU and the next place holding college shall be declared as joint medalists. Further RESOLVED to issue the Merit Certificates to both the teams with the same position i.e., First / Second / Third. (This procedure may be adopted on trail basis for the academic year 2016-17).
- 10 RESOLVED to develop online registration process for submitting Eligibilities proformas for the Inter-Collegiate tournaments and also to create online database of results and Inter-University Participants list from the academic year 2016-17. Further, RESOLVED to upload all the previous data into the Database for online access.
- 11 RESOLVED to authorize the Secretary, Sports Board to prepare Display Boards with the photographs related to the conduct of Inter-University Tournaments, Medalists and all other achievements and activities of the Sports Board in view of NAAC.
- 12 RESOLVED to continue the services of Sri.K.Amaranadh, Weightlifting Coach for the Weightlifting Center of Excellence of ANU for two more years with the same remuneration of Rs.25000/- per month.
- 13 RESOLVED to establish a new Center of Excellence in Athletics from the Academic year 2016-17.
- 14 RESOLVED to request the SAI to conduct NSNIS Six Weeks Certificate course at Acharya Nagarjuna University Campus for the year 2017 also.

- 15 RESOLVED to request the university authorities to consider to conduct Certificate courses in Cricket, Strength and Conditioning in collaboration with Andhra Cricket Association.
- 16 RESOLVED to authorize the Secretary, Sports Board to invite the corporate companies to sponsor the Centers of Excellence in Sports of Acharya Nagarjuna University under the CSR activities.
- 17 RESOLVED to request the university authorities to consider to send proposals to APSCHE to conduct AP Inter-University Tournament from the academic year 2016-17.
- 18 RESOLVED to request the Commissionerate of collegiate Education, Govt. of Andhra Pradesh to conduct Yuvatharangam Sports Competitions in all events by inviting the Winner and Runners of Inter-Collegiate Tournaments of each University.
- 19 RESOLVED to request the University authorities to send proposal to Sports Authority of India to establish STC center / Sports School / Sports Hostel / Extension center of STC / Center of Excellence in Weightlifting & Athletics for University players on the University Campus, as the Acharya Nagarjuna University is going to be the nearest university to the capital of Andhra Pradesh.
- 20 RESOLVED to send proposals to Govt. of Andhra Pradesh, to conduct long term coaching camp for the A.P. Teams for National Events and various National Championships on the University Campus.
- 21 RESOLVED to send proposals to Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Govt. of India to extend financial assistance to Acharya Nagarjuna University to conduct long term sports activities on the university campus
- 22 RESOLVED to establish a Mobile Human performance lab / Video Analysis lab for effective assessment of the players.
- 23 RESOLVED to develop online Physical Literacy Activity Database by the university for uploading the activities and minor games.
- 24 RESOLVED to enter an MOU with the Department of Tribal welfare and other such organizations of Andhra Pradesh to promote sports activities of the state.
- 25 RESOLVED to recommend to establish Cycle Clubs on the University campus and also in the affiliated colleges to promote Adventure activity.
