Item No.4:

After considering the resolutions of various zonal committees and other proposals received from the members and the Secretary, Sports Board, the following resolutions are passed.

- 1 RESOLVED to congratulate the Players, Coaches and Managers who won the medals in the Inter-University Tournaments during the year 2016-17.
- 2 RESOLVED to provide Sports Scholarships to Miss.G.Lalitha of SMPA Degree College, Cherukupalli for winning medal in All India Inter university competitions from August, 2017 @ Rs.5000/- per month till the completion of the course.
- 4 Resolved to enhance the TA & DA for the players and officials of Acharya Nagarjuna University to participate in the IUT from the academic year 2017-18 as follows.
 - a. DA for players attending the university team coaching camp Rs.200/- per day.
 - b. DA for players participating in the Inter university tournament with in the state and journey days Rs.275/- per day

- 14 RESOLVED to conduct All India Inter University Athletic meet at ANU in the month of December 2017. Further Resolved to authorize the Department of Physical Education, Acharya Nagarjuna University to approach sponsors for the meet.
- 15 RESOLVED to approve the proposal of SAAP Vide letter No.SAAP/SCS/EST-COE-Ath/2017 to start the Center of Excellence for Athletics on the University campus by providing free accommodation for forty athletes (Boys & Girls) and to utilize the new Synthetic Athletic Track for training.
- 16 RESOLVED to approve the proposal of SAAP vide letter No.SAAP/A&SS/61/SPORTS Medicine/Advisor/2017 to institute Advance sports Medicine Center, Human performance lab on the university campus and to provide space to Dr.Dandamudi P.S.Prasad, Honorary Advisor to SAAP (Sports Medicine, Economist & Research) Professor and Programme Director School of Health Sciences and Research Spots Technology, JNTU, Kakinada.
- 17 RESOLVED to develop advance facilities like Turf Hockey fields, Football Fields, Fencing, Shooting, Judo, Taekwondo and also Human performance lab with the financial assistance of SAAP/ SAI or any other agency promoting sports.
- 18 RESOLVED to conduct NIS Six week certificate course on the University Campus during 2018-also.
- 19 RESOLVED to conduct National Seminar on Yoga and Workshop on Athletics.
- 20 RESOLVED to request SAAP to conduct A.P. Inter University tournament on the University campus for the academic year 2017-18.
- 21 RESOLVED to conduct Inter-Collegiate athletic and weightlifting competitions under two groups i.e Juniors between 17 and 20 years and open category below 25 years.
- 22 RESOLVED to insist all the colleges to participate in the Inter collegiate tournaments. The Registrar, ANU may be requested to pursue the colleges to participate at least in two inter-collegiate events.
- 23 RESOLVED to construct Warm up Synthetic Athletic Track, Sports Hostel and obtain equipment with the financial assistance of SAAP and swimming pool with the financial assistance RUSA.
- 24 RESOLVED to enter an MOU with Karanam Malleswari Foundation to promote weightlifting center of excellence of ANU.
- 25 RESOLVED to request the university authorities to construct 50 toilets and bathrooms in the play fields to meet the needs of players attending the mass sports activities.
- 26 RESOLVED to send proposal to SAI to establish STC center and extension centers on the university campus for Athletics, Weightlifting and other games.
- 27 RESOLVED to approve the proposal of the Department of Tribal Welfare to enter an MOU with university to promote sports in Tribal Welfare Schools in Andhra Pradesh.
- 28 Further resolved to authorize the Department of Physical Education to pursue the other departments in AP also to associate in the development of sports so that Acharya Nagarjuna University can emerge as consulting agency for development of sports in Andhra Pradesh.
- 29 RESOLVED to adopt the new eligibility rules of AIU from the academic year 2017-18, wherein the age limit for the participation in the Inter-University tournament is fixed as 17 to 25 years for all games / sports.

- 30 RESOLVED to authorize the Secretary, Sports Board to invite the corporate companies to sponsor the Centers of Excellence in Sports of Acharya Nagarjuna University under the CSR activities.
- 31 RESOLVED to send proposals to Govt. of Andhra Pradesh, and State Sports Associations to conduct long term coaching camp for the A.P. Teams for National Events and various National Championships on the University Campus.
