### **About University College of Sciences**

I would like to congratulate all the students who joined in our University for the Academic year 2016-17 for choosing University College of Sciences, Acharya Nagarjuna University for their higher degree. I wish that the freshers and senior students will have a happy and fruitful stay in the campus.

The University College of Sciences have 14 Departments and offering 18 courses. There are 1078 PG students in all the Science Courses.

Research admissions for M.Phil/Ph.D. programmes into various departments have been made in the year 2015-16 by admitting nearly 380 research students under Full Time, Part Time and Extra Mural Research category. Some of the departments are getting financial assistance from Governmental agencies under SAP and Non-SAP category for improving their infrastructural and laboratory facilities in the departments. Botany, Physics, Zoology and Statistics are in second phase, while Chemistry is in Non-SAP category. Some of the departments are expected to receive financial assistance under FIST Programme.
