QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE POST OF PEON (OFFICE SUBORDINATE):-

For the post of Peon (Office Subordinate), qualification shall be pass in VII Class. The Government of Andhra Pradesh rules will be subscribed.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE POST OF ASSISTANT PROFESSOR (RESEARCH OFFICER) AS PER THE UGC REGULATIONS, 2018 READ WITH THE G.O.Ms.No. 14, HE (UE) DEPARTMENT, DATED 13.02.2019 AS PER THE GUIDELINES OF DR. AMBEDKAR FOUNDATION, NEW DELHI:

The Candidates possessing following qualifications for the post of Assistant Professor (Research Officer) as per the UGC regulations, 2018 read with G.O.Ms.No.14, Higher Education, dated 13.2.2019 in the above disciplines, i.e., Economics/Political Science/ Religious Studies/ Philosophy/ Constitutional Studies/ Education/ Anthropology/ Sociology/ Social Work/ Law/ Human Rights/ Commerce/Management, are eligible.

(i) A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned/relevant/allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.

(ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET :

Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances / Bye-Laws / Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/ SLET/ SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;
- b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- d) The Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;

e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D work in conferences/seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC / ICSSR/ CSIR or any similar agency.

The fulfillment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

Note: NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET.

B. The Ph.D degree has been obtained from a foreign university/institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following: (i) Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) (ii) the Times Higher Education (THE) or (iii) the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai).

General instructions

1. Applicant should send filled in prescribed application with details along with bio-data on or before last date prescribed along with all self-attested testimonials, certificates and all supporting documents relating to the post.
2. Candidates must enclose self- attested copies of concerned certificates. In the absence of the attested copies of Mark sheets/Certificates etc., application will be rejected and applicants will not be called for interview. No requests for review of application will be considered.
3. The Last Date for submission of Application 11.01.2023.
4. Applicant must produce original testimonials, certificates and other documents at the time of interview, if called.
5. Processing fee of Rs.1,000/- be paid through demad draft (from any nationalised bank) drawn in favour of the Registrar, Acharya Nagarjuna University for the post of Assistant Professor (Research Officer) and Rs.250/- for the post of Peon (Office Subordinate).
6. A candidate who knowingly or will-fully furnishes incorrect or false particulars or suppresses material Information, will be disqualified and if appointed will be liable for dismissal from service, without notice.
7. If any additional information is to be given, the information in separate sheet should be provided by the applicant as attachment.

8. The candidate must possess the required qualifications at the time of last date fixed for receipt of applications by post in the notification by the University i.e. 11.01.2023.
9. The persons belonging to SC, ST, BC or other weaker sections of the society may be given preference in filling the above posts.
10. Candidates, if called for interview, will have to attend the interview at his/her own expense.
11. The University reserves the right to fill or not to fill in any post or to alter the number of posts in any cadre or in any / all the subjects or make any amendments, to the posts.
12. The applicant must be fluent in English in both spoken and written forms.
13. The applicant if appointed may be assigned other academic or administrative responsibilities in addition to the duties of Chair.
14. The University shall verify the antecedents or documents submitted by the candidate within three month of the joining. In case, it is detected at any time that the documents submitted by the candidates are fake or the candidate has clandestine antecedents / background and has suppressed or altered the said information, then his/her services shall be terminated immediately and appropriate action shall be initiated as deemed fit.
15. The Selected candidate will have to sign a contract with the University. This appointment shall be purely on fixed tenure basis for a period of 5 years under a contract and the tenure shall be at the sole discretion of the University and as per the requirements of the University and shall be under strict review at all times. The first one year shall be treated as period of probation. The University can discontinue the contract at any point of the time for any reason whatsoever with a notice period as set in the contract.
16. The contract can be further extended subject to funding agency approval and university rules and subject to satisfactory performance.
17. Candidates already in employment would be required to submit their application through proper channel, and submit 'No Objection Certificate', Experience Certificate from the Employer failing which they

may not be considered. However, they may produce Original 'No Objection Certificate' etc. at the time of interview.

18. Mere eligibility will not entitle any candidate for being called for interview. Applicants having better qualifications in as per the thrust area of Ambedkar Chair of ANU will be given preference.
19. The candidates will be called for interview, wherever applicable, by the University on the recommendations of Screening/Scrutiny Committee.
20. Experience and qualification will be reckoned as on the last date of submission of application.
21. The service conditions including AGP and GP shall be as per UGC/University Rules/Norms.
22. In case of any dispute/ambiguity that may occur in the process of selection, the decision of the University shall be final.
23. Canvassing in any form will be a disqualification.
24. No interim correspondence shall be entertained.
25. Candidates awarded degree by Foreign Universities are required to submit Equivalence Certificate issued by Association of India University, New Delhi.
