1. A WEEK LONG AWARENESS PROGRAM ON HUMAN RIGHTS

Date -03.12.2022 to 10.12.2022

Center for Community Social Responsibility &Anti Human Trafficking Club, Acharya Nagarjuna University in association with Human Rights Committee for Protection organized a week long state level awareness program on Human Rights in commemoration of World Human Rights Day (10.12.2022). Honourable Home Minister of Andhra Pradesh Smt.Taneti Vanitha garu inaugurated the first phase of World Human Rights Awareness campaign from 03-12-2022 to 10-12-2022 commemorating 75 years of U.N. Declaration of Human Rights by releasing the Posters at Home Minister's Camp Office, Kovvuru in East Godavari district, Andhra Pradesh.



Second day, a rally was organized in the morning in the presence of the honorable Vice chancellor Prof. Raja Sekhar Patteti, Registrar, Prof.B.Karuna along with faculty members from various departments. Students from various departments of the university have took part

in the rally. In the afternoon session, essay competition as held on the topic "Implementation of international human rights law at the national level".



Awareness workshops were held throughout the state's colleges and institutions on the program's consecutive days. The winners of the essay competition received their awards on the program's final day.

2.BATTERY OPERATED VEHICLE INAUGURATION

Honorable Vice Chancellor, Prof. Raja Sekhar Pattetiinaugurated the battery operated vehicles for free transportation of the differently-abled and elderly people who have trouble getting around the institution. For the sake of the people on the campus, a 13.5 lakh investment was made for the two battery operated vehicles. The services of these cars are available to hostel residing disabled students who need to get to their respective colleges and departments. These two vehicles are available from 11:00 am, and typically depart from the institution's main gate. On this occasion the vice chancellor stated that the university is at the top of the list globally for the services provided to students. He further stated that two new buses had been added for students travelling from Vijayawada and Guntur.



3. BAMBOO CRAFT TRAINING FOR INMATES OF UJJAWALA HOME

Date – 27.02.2023 to 04.03.2023

Honorable Vice Chancellor, Prof. Raja Sekhar Pattetiinaugurated the one week free training program on bamboo crafts for inmates of Ujjwala home organized by Center for community social responsibility, Acharya Nagarjuna University. Dr. B. Shekar, an assistant professor in the department of fine arts, was engaged as the instructor to provide the training. On the first day of the training session, inputs were given on how to use the tools while creating bamboo crafts. The design drafting inputs were given from the following days to the inmates. Many crafts like pen stand, photo frame, wall lamp, bullock cart etc. were created by the inmates. These skills help them further in future for their livelyhoood.



4. ACADEMIC EXHIBITION-2023

Acharya Nagarjuna university held an academic exhibition, a three day program, on the theme "Global Science for the well being of Humanity".
