About the University

Acharya Nagarjuna University, is quite significant in that the greatest Buddhist preceptor and philosopher Acharya Nagarjuna founded University on the banks of river Krishna some centuries ago. In 1967, Andhra University started a Post - graduate centre in Nallapadu, Guntur District, Andhra Pradesh, as an Extension Center to cater the needs of higher education of the people of this region. It is in the fitness of things that a university should grow from this Center to fulfill the desire of the people of this belt. Accordingly, Nagarjuna University came into being in August 1976.

Acharya Nagarjuna University since then has grown into a large University with Academic Departments having over 400 affiliated colleges offering Under-Graduate, Post-Graduate, Engineering, Education, Law, Pharmacy and Oriental Languages courses. Now it has 55 Post-Graduate teaching-cum research courses on the campus, while around 70 affiliated colleges offer PG. Courses.

About the Chair

Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Chair was established in 1993, supported by Dr. Ambedkar Foundation, New Delhi, Govt. of India, Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment Dr. B.R. Ambedkar made a concrete efforts in the Constitution and ensured equally all the citizens the educational opportunities. Ambedkar thought "Education is something which ought to be brought within the reach of everyone".

The vision of Dr. Ambedkar on education will be accomplished through the New Education Policy (2020). The NEP is the first education policy for the 21st century aiming to build character and prepare the youth for gainful and benefitting employment while being aligned to the Indian ethos. NEP2020 affirms efforts will be made for bring the gender gap as well as socio economic disadvantaged groups in access participation and learning outcomes.
